## Public Opinion Poll on the "Fugitive Offenders Ordinance" Amendment

The Scholars' Alliance for Academic Freedom (SAAF) was formed in 2015 by 60 academics from various tertiary institutes in Hong Kong. The aim of the Alliance is to defend academic freedom and to sustain solidarity in the academic community.

Last month, the SAAF commissioned the Public Opinion Programme of the University of Hong Kong to conduct an opinion survey on the "Fugitive Offenders Ordinance" Amendment.
