Independent Police Complaints Council Public Opinion Survey

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Background

- > Fourth consecutive annual survey conducted by HKUPOP since 2013
- Objective:
 - To measure public awareness, perception, knowledge and expectation on IPCC;
 - To identify major channels of public knowledge about IPCC;
 - To identify the most visible police complaint cases;
 - To investigate main areas of public concern in police complaints;
 - To identify the direction of IPCC's publicity initiatives
- > POP consulted IPCC when designing the questionnaire but POP retained full autonomy in every aspect of the study and <u>takes full responsibility</u> for all findings reported.
- This year's findings have already been presented to the IPCC Publicity and Survey Committee and the Council for discussion. They are open for public consumption after today's press conference.

Survey method: Telephone survey conducted by telephone

Response rate: 67.1%

all percentages should be no more than +/-3.2

percentage points at 95% confidence level)

Findings


Statistical tests of "difference-of-proportions" and "difference-of-means" have been employed wherever applicable to check for significant changes from 2013 to 2014, from 2014 to 2015, and from 2015 to 2016.

* denotes statistical significance at p < 0.05 level


Awareness of IPCC

Over 80% have heard of IPCC














Description of IPCC

(read out to all respondents prior to a series of image profile questions)

"The IPCC is an organisation independent from the Hong Kong Police Force and its Members are appointed by the Chief Executive. It is an important part of the two-tier police complaints system in Hong Kong, specialising in observing, monitoring and reviewing complaints made by the public against the police force via CAPO. Although the complaints are made through CAPO, the investigation results must be endorsed by the IPCC to ensure that the investigation is fair, impartial and transparent."







More than one-third expressed confidence in IPCC




Over one-third are <u>confident</u> in the <u>two-tier complaints system</u>

Significantly more younger respondents and those with tertiary education perceive IPCC's image negatively







IPCC's negative image is mainly associated with its perceived <u>unfairness and partiality</u>







More than one-third express hope on IPCC's fair, impartial and transparent manner



[Q21] Lastly, what are your expectations on IPCC? Any more? (Do not read out options, multiple answers allowed) 最後,整體而言你對「監警會」有乜野期望? (不讀答案,可選多項)

- The methodology of this annual survey conducted by HKUPOP is exactly the same as that of previous three surveys, all significant changes in public opinion are not due to methodological shifts.
- The continued polarization of the political environment over the year past, and people's changing attitudes towards the Hong Kong Police Force following the Occupy Movement should be the most important factors causing changes to IPCC's image profile over the year past.
- Overall, IPCC still maintains a fairly positive public image, as 81% of our survey respondents having heard of IPCC, 95% could give it a satisfaction score averaged at 56.1 marks, and 52% perceived IPCC positively, roughly translating to "quite positive" overall.

- However, compared to one year ago, these positive feedbacks have dropped. In terms of perceived performance, net satisfaction has dropped from 25 to 10 percentage points, while satisfaction rating dropped from 60.3 to 56.1. People's net confidence in IPCC and the two-tier police complaints system have dropped from 20 percentage points to just 5 and 6, and people's net perception of IPCC has dropped from 46 to 38 percentage points, and the drop is especially significant among the youngest and most educated respondents.
- A four-pronged image profile analysis shows that IPCC is perceived as an independent and impartial/objective organization, but not that efficient nor transparent. A worrying trend is that significantly more people than before are rating these four aspects negatively.

- Upon probing, two attributes seem to have affected IPCC's public image: independence and impartiality. On independence, 63% were aware that IPCC is entirely independent of the Police, 46% considered IPCC had acted independently in monitoring and reviewing public complaints of the Police. However, on impartiality, a lower percentage of 40% considered IPCC had done its work impartially and objectively. Looking ahead, 36% hoped that IPCC could handle cases in a fair, impartial and transparent manner.
- As society continues to become polarized, and attitudes towards the Hong Kong Police Force politicized, the monitoring and reviewing of public complaints against the Police will continue to pose big challenges to the IPCC in the years to come.
