I. Information on the Workshop

1. Introduction

The 4th International Workshop on Internet Survey Methods is being organized by Statistics Korea. This workshop will provide a platform for international experts in the field of web surveys to share their knowledge and experience on conducting the surveys and how to ensure the quality of survey outcomes.

The theme of the 4th International Workshop on Internet Survey Methods is "Quality Improvement of Official Statistics and the Role of Internet Survey Methods." The Workshop will explore major concerns that national statistical offices are facing in the era of Internet and how each office is coping with the changes in environment of conducting surveys. National case studies and researches on using Internet surveys in official statistics will be presented. At the same time, the Workshop will touch the general issues of Internet surveys such as mixed-mode survey and survey planning, weighting and estimation and technical issues of Internet surveys.



8.1. To go from the airport to Daejeon


Step 1) Take an Airport Limousine Bus from Incheon International Airport to Daejeon









Make sure that the limousine stop for Daejeon is 9D in front of the passenger terminal building. The fare for a one-way ticket varies from KRW 22,100 or KRW 24,300 according to the limousine class. Ticket office is in side of the airport and next to the bus stop 9D. Please note that the last bus to leave Incheon International Airport for Daejeon is 23:10pm. The bus from Incheon International Airport to Daejeon runs every 20 or 30 minutes. It will take approximately 3 hours. Participants are advised to get off the second bus stop in Daejeon which is Government Complex. (Korean pronounciation : Jeongbu Daejeon Cheongsa Stop)

When you get off the airport limousine bus at Government Complex Daejeon, you are advised to take a taxi from the bus stop to Hotel Interciti. There are always some taxis near the Government Complex Bus Stop waiting for customers. After getting in a taxi, please tell the driver the name of the hotel(Hotel Interciti) or show the card below. It will take about 15~20 minutes and cost about KRW 5,000~8,000 since it depends on the traffic condition.
