Research Background

- Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan, are collectively called the Greater China Region.
- So alike yet so different in terms of social, cultural, economic and political conditions.
- With the ever-increasing frequent exchanges and interactions of people in the region, how their people see their lives and societies to be similar with, or different from, each other provides valuable indicators for social scientists to understand the region.

Research Background

- A joint survey across the four societies is to measure people's appraisal of their society's democracy, freedom, prosperity and stability.
- It will also measure people's satisfaction with their society's economic and political development, as well as their perception of government officials in general.
- Compare and discuss the opinions gathered, both in terms of differences among different societies, as well as among different demographic groups within and across these societies.
- An outgrowth of the cross national survey on "Satisfaction in Daily Life in Asia Survey" initiated by ANPOR
- An extension of the ANPOR survey both in terms of scope and geographical coverage



Life Satisfaction


Only Household income in Taiwan gets negative NET results.





Take Care of Health & Consult Doctor






Society Evaluation

China evaluates stable society with highest score;



Current Political and Economical Condition Satisfaction


China gives the satisfaction of both current political and economic condition with highest score;


Gov Officials understand Public Evaluation

All regions consider that government officials fail to understand views of majority of the general public.




Life Satisfaction-Demo Net Value

The elder or people with low level of education give higher scores of housing satisfaction in three regions.




Life Satisfaction-Demo Net Value (Cont')

Male in HK, and male, people with middle age, people with middle or high level of education in Macao give job satisfaction with higher score.




Take Care of Health & Consult Doctor-Demo Net Value

All age groups in Taiwan get negative NET results in Take Care of Health, the elder, the higher negative percentage; Male and middle age people in Macau and young people in China are less likely to consult doctors in the past one month.



Society Evaluation - Demo Net Value


The elder, people with low level of education tend to rate society with higher scores in all three society, Hong Kong, Macau and China.




Society Evaluation - Demo Net Value (Cont')

Young and elder people in Macau are more likely to consider the society as prosperous, while the elder or people with low level of education in China tent to hold this opinion.

People with middle level of education in HK, the old people in Taiwan, male in China are more like to consider the society as stable.



Current Political and Economical Condition Satisfaction-Demo Net Value




Gov Officials understand Public Evaluation - Demo Net Value
